

Annual Plan Update

The HATC Board of Commissioners adopted a local preference for a tenant-based voucher over other project-based to tenant-based voucher requests to participants residing in project-based voucher-assisted properties Pear Blossom Place and Pear Street Apartments. This preference is being offered as part of the Continuum of Care to end homelessness for families with children and children aging out of foster care. Pear Blossom Place, with seven units, is the only permanent housing with intensive case management for homeless families with children in Thurston County. Pear Street Apartments, with six units, is the only permanent housing with intensive case management for youth aging out of foster care in Thurston County.

The HATC Board of Commissioners adopted a local preference for a limited local preference for the Mainstream 2017 award of 50 vouchers. This preference is targeted to serve families with at least one non-elderly disabled adult member who is homeless, at risk of homelessness, living in an institution or at risk of institutionalization. This targeted preference may skip over other applicants on the HCV waiting list and referrals may be made to the HCV waiting list during times when it is closed.
